Pima County *SAFR Center*

The Pima County Sobering Alternative for Recovery (SAFR) Center provides 24/7, short-term stabilization for adults experiencing substance use disorder. The SAFR Center is operated by Community Bridges, Inc. (CBI), with funding approved by the Pima County Board of Supervisors using opioid settlement funds.

The SAFR Center is a treatment program that serves adults 18 years and older. Services can be accessed through community referrals including Law enforcement and first-responder drop-offs as a therapeutic deflection option, hospital referrals, and community partner referrals.

Onsite staff can assist with referrals to appropriate higher level of medical or psychiatric care when needed.

The SAFR Center is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Police Department Process

- ◆ Dedicated entrance, and average turnaround time of 3 minutes

Services

- ◆ Screening and assessment of medical and behavioral health status
- ◆ Crisis stabilization, including assessment, evaluation, observation, treatment, and stabilization planning
- ◆ On site treatment and connection to Substance Use Disorder services, including:
 - ◇ Induction and/or continuation of MAT for Opioid Use Disorder
 - ◇ Management of substance withdrawal
 - ◇ Referral and connection to various levels of care per ASAM criteria
 - ◇ Dispense take-home Naloxone upon discharge or request
- ◆ Short term behavioral health residential services (up to 96 hours)
- ◆ Care Management and Navigation Services
- ◆ Drop-off/disposition/deflection center for law enforcement
- ◆ Accepts two pets per person. Unlicensed/unvaccinated pets may be processed and aggressive pets do not qualify
- ◆ Storage for clients' materials is offered and the CBI team can transport these items

Referral Requirements

- ◆ Appropriate Candidates
 - ◇ Substance Use related needs, and;
 - ◇ Individuals that are open to treatment
- ◆ Must come from community partner referral source

Exclusion Criteria

- ◆ Must be 18 years or older
- ◆ Primary concern of Substance Use required
